Sessions: Inspire to Action

Each session weaves together a focused TED-style talk, a real-life story, a panel conversation, and time to reflect with those around you. Together, these elements are designed to inspire action, moving you from ideas to meaningful steps in everyday disciple-making.

Workshops: Equip for Effectiveness

Workshops provide 90 minutes of interactive, hands-on learning tied directly to each session's theme. With four options per session, these spaces are crafted to equip you for effectiveness, helping you practice and apply tools and principles in your own life and context. At the end, you'll be invited to join a 6-8 month virtual cohort, an opportunity to keep growing and practicing what you've learned alongside others.

Main Session Topics

The main sessions will tie together what the ALL Initiative is all about: **ALL is a community of everyday disciples who make disciples in daily life, reaching Europe.** Each session will cover a section of this vision, so that you can be inspired and equipped to make disciples in your everyday life.

ALL is a community
<i>Discipleship happens best together. Jesus didn't call isolated followers—He formed a community that learned, served, and grew side by side. Making disciples is not a solo act but a shared journey of faith, where we find encouragement, accountability, and growth as we follow Jesus together.</i>
ALL is about everyone
<i>Disciple-making is not reserved for the "experts." Every follower of Jesus is called and empowered by the Holy Spirit to participate in God's mission. This segment affirms that no one is too ordinary, unqualified, or unequipped to be a part of what God is doing.</i>
ALL is about making disciples
<i>The Great Commission is at the heart of Jesus' call to His followers. Making disciples means introducing people to Jesus, walking with them as they grow in faith, and helping them multiply by discipling others. It's about both evangelism and spiritual formation, bringing people to maturity in Christ and equipping them to do the same for others.</i>
ALL is about every day
<i>Disciple-making isn't an event. It's a lifestyle. It's about how to integrate Jesus' mission into daily routines—being present, prayerful, and purposeful wherever life happens: at the dinner table, in conversations, at work and on the go.</i>

Session Breakdown
15 min – TED-style Talk A focused, inspiring message on the session theme.
5 min – Video Story Real-life example of everyday disciple-making in action.
30 min – Panel Interview Honest conversation and insights from practitioners.
15 min – Group Discussion Reflect and share with those sitting around you.

Connected to the Theme

90-Minute Format

Plenty of time to go deep and get practical, even beginning to apply things right away. A 30-minute break helps you move easily between workshops.

These aren't lecture-style workshops. You'll engage, practice, and apply ideas together in ways that make sense for your everyday life and ministry.
