

Main Session Topics

The main sessions will tie together what the ALL Initiative is all about: **ALL is a community of everyday disciples who make disciples in daily life, reaching Europe.** Each session will cover a section of this vision, so that you can be inspired and equipped to make disciples in your everyday life.

ALL is a community

Discipleship happens best together. Jesus didn't call isolated followers—He formed a community that learned, served, and grew side by side. Making disciples is not a solo act but a shared journey of faith, where we find encouragement, accountability, and growth as we follow Jesus together.

ALL is about everyone

Disciple-making is not reserved for the "experts." Every follower of Jesus is called and empowered by the Holy Spirit to participate in God's mission. This segment affirms that no one is too ordinary, unqualified, or unequipped to be a part of what God is doing.

ALL is about making disciples

The Great Commission is at the heart of Jesus' call to His followers. Making disciples means introducing people to Jesus, walking with them as they grow in faith, and helping them multiply by discipling others. It's about both evangelism and spiritual formation, bringing people to maturity in Christ and equipping them to do the same for others.

ALL is about every day

Disciple-making isn't an event. It's a lifestyle. It's about how to integrate Jesus' mission into daily routines—being present, prayerful, and purposeful wherever life happens: at the dinner table, in conversations, at work and on the go.

A focused, inspiring message on the session theme.

5 min – Video Story

Real-life example of everyday disciple-making in action.

30 min – Panel Interview

Honest conversation and insights from practitioners.

15 min – Group Discussion

Reflect and share with those sitting around you.

Workshop 1 | Family on Mission: Living and Multiplying Community Together

with Bodo Park | Frankfurt, Germany | Süd Projekt

What does it look like to live as a spiritual family on mission, sharing everyday life with purpose? In this workshop, Bodo Park draws from his experience in missional house church planting to explore how authentic community grows through shared rhythms, intentional relationships, and a united commitment to making disciples. Participants will discover simple, practical practices that help communities live as a family on mission, supporting one another, multiplying naturally, and reaching others through everyday life. Expect an engaging and relational session that connects the vision of community from the main session with concrete and lived examples.

In this workshop, we explore Psalm 127 to glean wisdom from the pattern of family: purposeful prayer coupled with strategic planning, equipping, and releasing of mature people who attract others to relationally engage in God's Word. In addition, join Ellie and others in the Community Bible Study family to discuss real stories of how God has utilised everyday people to expand His family in extraordinary ways.

Workshop 3 | Moving from Bible Study to Missional Community

with Josh Walsh | Liverpool, United Kingdom | Greater Europe Mission UK

Discover how ordinary small groups can grow into communities that live with purpose, accountability, and shared mission. Josh Walsh will introduce practical mindset shifts and simple rhythms that help groups move beyond information and into active disciple making. Participants will identify common barriers, learn healthy practices for missional momentum, and leave with steps they can apply immediately in their own context.

What does it take for an ordinary small group to become a community that lives with purpose, multiplication, and shared mission? In this workshop Josh will draw from years of experience in church planting and coaching groups to move beyond comfort and into intentional disciple making. You will learn how small groups can shift from simply gathering for Bible study to becoming communities that carry momentum and mission together. We will explore the mindsets and practices that help people break out of familiar patterns and embrace rhythms that lead to growth, accountability, spiritual movement, and multiplication.

Expect an interactive environment where you will work together in teams, identify barriers that keep groups stuck, and discover practical rhythms you can apply to help any group move toward genuine missional community.

Workshop 5 | The Eight Steps of the Missions Continuum: From the Local Church to the Mission Field

This workshop is a practical, interactive space designed to help everyday believers understand how cross-cultural missions actually happen and what role they play in that process. Using the Eight Steps of the Missions Continuum, participants will explore how the path from the local church to the mission field is shaped by ordinary discipleship, shared obedience, and faithful community life.

Through guided discussion, reflection, and participant sharing, we will explore practical questions such as: What task has Jesus actually given the church? Where do I fit in that task right now? What barriers keep believers and churches from living this out? And how can everyday disciples help shape a global vision in their church that leads to faithful cross-cultural sending? Participants will leave with a clearer understanding of the Eight Steps, how they move from the local church to the mission field, and how their everyday discipleship can help their church faithfully make disciples of all nations.

Together, we will explore how to make this a reality in our everyday lives. We will learn to recognise what the Father is doing, to listen to the Spirit guiding us in ordinary moments, and to step into disciple-making with confidence.

Jane will guide us in simple, accessible practices of hearing God, using the spiritual "toolbox" that every believer carries. During this interactive session, through reflection, listening prayer and practice appreciation, you will not only learn but also experience what it means to join God in His work wherever and whenever.

Using the simple and reproducible tool of “The Window”, we will learn a framework that helps everyday believers reflect on their passions, gifts and the needs around them, and begin to identify their most strategic role in God’s mission and live out a holistic lifestyle of discipleship that includes God’s heart for all nations. Participants will be given an overview of the full journey, with a brief taster of one or two core tools such as extraordinary prayer, mapping their oikos, or Discovery Bible Studies. The session is designed to demystify disciple-making, build confidence, and inspire ordinary Christians to follow Jesus in their neighbourhoods, workplaces, and communities, seeing communities of light emerge from everyday life.

Workshop 11 | Become a Cojourner

with Wojtek Kowalewski | Wroclaw, Poland | Golden Apple Institute

This workshop introduces the CoJourney approach, a simple and relational way of joining people on their spiritual journeys by meeting them exactly where they are. Participants will learn how everyday conversations can lead naturally into meaningful spiritual engagement, and how discipling becomes a way of life rather than a program.

During the session, participants will work with the Oikos Mapping tool to identify the people already present in their relational world and to reflect on their spiritual openness and needs. They will practice the CoJourney conversational framework in table groups and will develop a clear nextstep plan for someone on their Oikos map. The workshop blends short teaching, guided reflection and practical group exercises so that each participant leaves with confidence and a concrete plan for initiating gospelcentered conversations where they live, work, learn and play.

The tools used in this workshop include the Oikos Map, the CoJourney conversation framework and facilitated table exercises designed to move participants immediately from insight to action.

Workshop 12 | The Impact of Short-Term Discipleship

This workshop introduces the biblical principles and practical value of Short Term Discipleship. Through group engagement with key Scripture passages, participants will observe how Jesus and Paul helped new believers begin obeying Jesus quickly while avoiding unhealthy dependence on a mentor.

We will explore the difference between short term and long term discipleship, using images such as milk and solid food, and identify the essential practices that new believers can begin right away, as seen in Acts 2:36 to 47. The workshop also highlights how Paul created space for new leaders to grow by stepping back at the right time.

Although brief in format, this approach leads to long term growth and multiplication by equipping everyday believers to make disciples simply, biblically and with confidence.

Karl's workshop offers a disruptive reframing of mission: presence before activity. Instead of starting with strategies or tasks, he explores how mission naturally flows from being with Jesus, drawing on his belief-behaviour-brand framework to show how deeply held beliefs shape the way others experience us. Through the law of indirect effort and insights from the early oikos communities, Karl invites participants to rediscover a way of life where Jesus is revealed not through programs or positions, but through the overflow of His presence in everyday relationships.
